- Panel 3 is inviting fifteen-minute presentations from members who have successfully worked with other academic or student affairs programs or with other institutions to develop and facilitate FCS programs. (Examples- shared degree programs, faculty and resources, general education courses, integrated general education outcomes in FCS content courses, College in High School, performance based funding)
